1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
3. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
4. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or

similar Category Products for 80% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

5. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1

**1. Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

1) Only designer approved vendors are eligible to participate in the Tender. Quotations received from other than approved vendors will not be considered & rejected.

2) (a) It is the responsibility of the vendor to collect Latest version of Drawings / QAP / Scope of Work and other relevant documents of Onboard Cooling System, Part No.: OCS - 365 16 01 02 00 00 [NASM & LR-LAC M] from Project / RCI before Initiating Procurement.

(b) All the raw material required for the supplies to be procured & manufactured by the vendor as per Part No. / Kit No. [Onboard Cooling System, Part No.: OCS - 365 16 01 02 00 00]

(c) The required Input material / Raw material for fabrication of Onboard Cooling System, Part No.: OCS - 365 16 01 02 00 00 [NASM & LR-LACM] is under vendor scope. Vendor should carry out all the raw material testing's as per Material Specification, Drawings & QAP.

FIM Details: No FIM will be issued by BDL.

(d) Items to be manufactured as per Drawing / Scope of Work / Documents (with latest amendments wherever applicable), issued by Project / RCI. After manufacturing, Dimensional Inspection should be carried out as per Drawing and required tests to be carried out by the vendor as per Documents. The components should be free from burrs, cracks & damages.

(e) Parts / Components / Assemblies shall be supplied as per Latest drawings / QA Plan / Technical specifications / Relevant standards which ever applicable

(f) The following certificates are to be submitted along with deliveries.

(i) Functional Testing Reports of all components

(ii) Calibration report of Pressure Transducer

(iii) Dew Point Measurement Report of Components and Assembly

(iv) Pure Air Monitor Test Report

(v) Warranty Certificate

(g) Vendor shall carry out QT & AT as per QAP Document. Total Quantities to be supplied by the vendor are 04 nos for NASM (03 nos AT & 01 no QT) and 03 nos (AT) for LRLACM. After QT, the tested units shall be yellow banded.

(h) Dew point test and PAM has to be carried out before Functional Testing (Test Detector Cooling) of Onboard Cooling System, Part No.: OCS - 365 16 01 02 00 00 [NASM & LR-LACM]. The Functional Testing (Test Detector Cooling) facility & Technical support will be provided by BDL and testing is under vendor scope.

(i) Vendor should not procure the raw material / bought out / imported items from countries sharing land border with India.

(j) Country of Origin Certificate of Raw Material to be provided.

3) (a) Vendor shall submit QA plan & take approval from MSQAA after receipt of purchase order. Vendor shall adhere to approved QA plan.

(b) Vendor shall inform MSQAA / BDL or his / her nominated Inspection agency at various stages as per QA matrix prior One Week to review / witness and give clearance for further processing.

4) Pre-Dispatch Inspection (PDI):

(a) Vendor has to intimate for PDI one week in advance before delivery to BDL.

(b) PDI will be carried out at manufacturer's/Vendor's place.

(c) The items shall be dispatched to BDL only after pre-dispatch inspection (PDI) by MSQAA / BDL or his / her nominated Inspection agency

5) (a) Inspection agency: Inspection agency is MSQAA / BDL or his / her nominated Inspection agency

(b) All the supplies should accompany with all the relevant inspection / test reports of the items cleared by the inspection agency.

(c) Final acceptance after receipt of the items at BDL stores along with I-Note / Green Card.

6) (a) The equipment used for fabrication and Inspection shall have valid calibration certificate.

(b) All the measuring instruments / gauges shall have valid calibration certificate and shall be produced to inspection agency of BDL on demand.

(c) All the fixtures, jigs, tools & Equipment necessary for Fabrication/Inspection/Testing/ is under vendor scope.

7) (a) All the Items shall be marked by engraving/labeling/providing tag to ensure identification of component/ heat cycle during and after fabrication.

(b) Engraving shall be done at the location marked/shown as in the drawing. For other components, don't have engraving location, shall be tagged/labeled with their identification number.

8) Complete inspection and documentation shall be carried out and maintained by the manufacturer as per drawings and QA plan document.

9) Replacement for the rejected items shall be provided on Priority basis at free of cost

10) Total cost of set along with item-wise cost to be furnished. However PO will be placed as a package on lowest offers. In case, if any vendor Quotes for less than the number of items given in the enquiry, his quotation stands rejected.

11) Delivery schedule:

(a) Quantity: 03 Nos AT Units & 01 No. QT Unit of Sl. No. 01 - On-Board Cooling System (NASM) to be supplied within T0+7 months (T0 is date of release of vetted PO from Inspection Agency i.e., BDL / MSQAA or their Nominated Inspection Agency]

(b) Quantity: 03 Nos AT Units of Sl. No. 02 - On-Board Cooling System (LR-LACM) to be supplied within T0+7 months (T0 is date of release of vetted PO from Inspection Agency i.e., BDL / MSQAA or their Nominated Inspection Agency]

(c) Early deliveries are acceptable.

12) Delivery Term: The items shall be delivered at BDL stores and free delivery to BDL (F.O.R. BDL, Kanchanbagh, Hyderabad).

13) Supplier has to take approval / permission from BDL in case of change in manufacturing process or input material or manufacturing facility.

14) Packing & Forwarding:

(a) Items should be securely packed as per standard specification / guidelines/ TSQD for severe road / rail / air / sea transport conditions and the packing charges borne by the supplier.

(b) Freight, Transit Insurance etc., is in supplier scope and at their cost.

15) Payment terms: 90% payment with 100 % taxes and duties will be made within 30 days after receipt and acceptance of material at BDL on pro rata basis. Balance 10% payment against submission of 5% PBG with validity till warranty period plus 3 months claim period. BDL reserves its right to release GST only after suppliers invoice / debit note is reflected in GSTR-2B/2A within the specified time limit mentioned in GST Law.

16) Security deposit: Security deposit shall be submitted by the successful bidders for 5% of the order value (by way of Online payment / Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque / bank guarantee from scheduled banks) within one week from the date of purchase order and valid up to successful execution of the order till the last delivery date as per purchase order plus 3 months claim period. SD will be released after successful completion of the order and against submission of performance bank guarantee as applicable.

17) Non-Disclosure Agreement: Vendor has to enter in to a Non-Disclosure Agreement as per the format provided by BDL.

18) Liquidated damages: Time is the essence of the P.O and delivery should be strictly insisted upon according to the delivery schedule given in the PO. In the event the supplier fails to deliver the goods / service, within the stipulated delivery period, BDL reserves the right to recover from the supplier, LD and not by way of penalty an amount as detailed in terms and conditions. A sum of 0.5% of the price only of the stores (including duties, taxes) which the supplier has failed to deliver as aforesaid for each week of delay or part thereof, subject to a maximum of 10%. In case of extension of delivery period, increase in taxes shall not be borne by BDL, if delay is attributable to vendor.

19) BDL reserves the right to process and finalize the tender among the technically acceptable offers by conducting on-line e-reverse auction ( after opening the price bids) and bringing all vendors to equal level playing field in respect of techno-commercial conditions or may finalize the tender without e-reverse auction , if required by BDL. The process adopted for e-reverse auction is at the discretion of BDL. The details of auctioning will be given to the vendors in advance and familiarization will be arranged for the same, if required.

20) The Prices indicated in the PO (After finalizing the bids and release of PO) are firm and fixed i.e., no subject alteration / variation on any account unless specified in the purchase order.

21) Purchase Preference (PP) Clause (Make in India): order 2017 is applicable details can be submitted with the bids.

22) "HSN Code: Vendor has to provide HSN code (six digit code) for the items".

23) GST Clause: "BDL reserves its right to release GST only after supplier's invoice/debit note is reflected in GSTR-2B/2A within the specified time limit mentioned in GST law".

24) Supplier shall not supply non-conforming product against specification.

25) In case of non-conformity product, supplier has to inform BDL for further disposition action (i.e.re-work, rejection etc.).

- 26) Supplier shall retain the product related records (Processes, Quality Records etc.,) up to 3years.
- 27) BDL, its customer and regulatory authorities having right of access to the applicable areas of all your facilities, at any level of supply chain, involved in our order and all applicable records.
- 28) Supplier shall ensure that the persons carrying out the manufacturing of items under this purchase order be aware of Product conformity requirements, Product safety and Importance of ethical behavior etc.,
- 29) Supplier shall notify to BDL in case of suspected/detected Counterfeit parts (if any) during any stage of manufacturing for its prevention of further use and quarantine of the same.
- 30) All Other Terms & conditions are applicable as per the General / Limited Terms and conditions attached .
- 31) It may be noted whenever special conditions are listed above; the same supersedes the conditions mentioned in General/Limited Terms & Conditions.

2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.

While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
